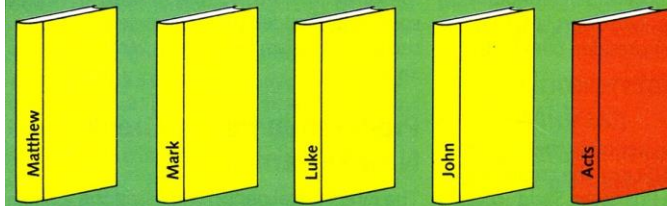


Christianity began, then, as a religious movement within Judaism and was viewed that way by Roman authorities for many decades. Although tradition holds that one of Jesus's disciples, Peter, founded the Christian church at Rome, the most important figure in early Christianity after Jesus was Paul of Tarsus. Paul reached out to non-Jews and transformed Christianity from a Jewish sect into a broader religious movement.

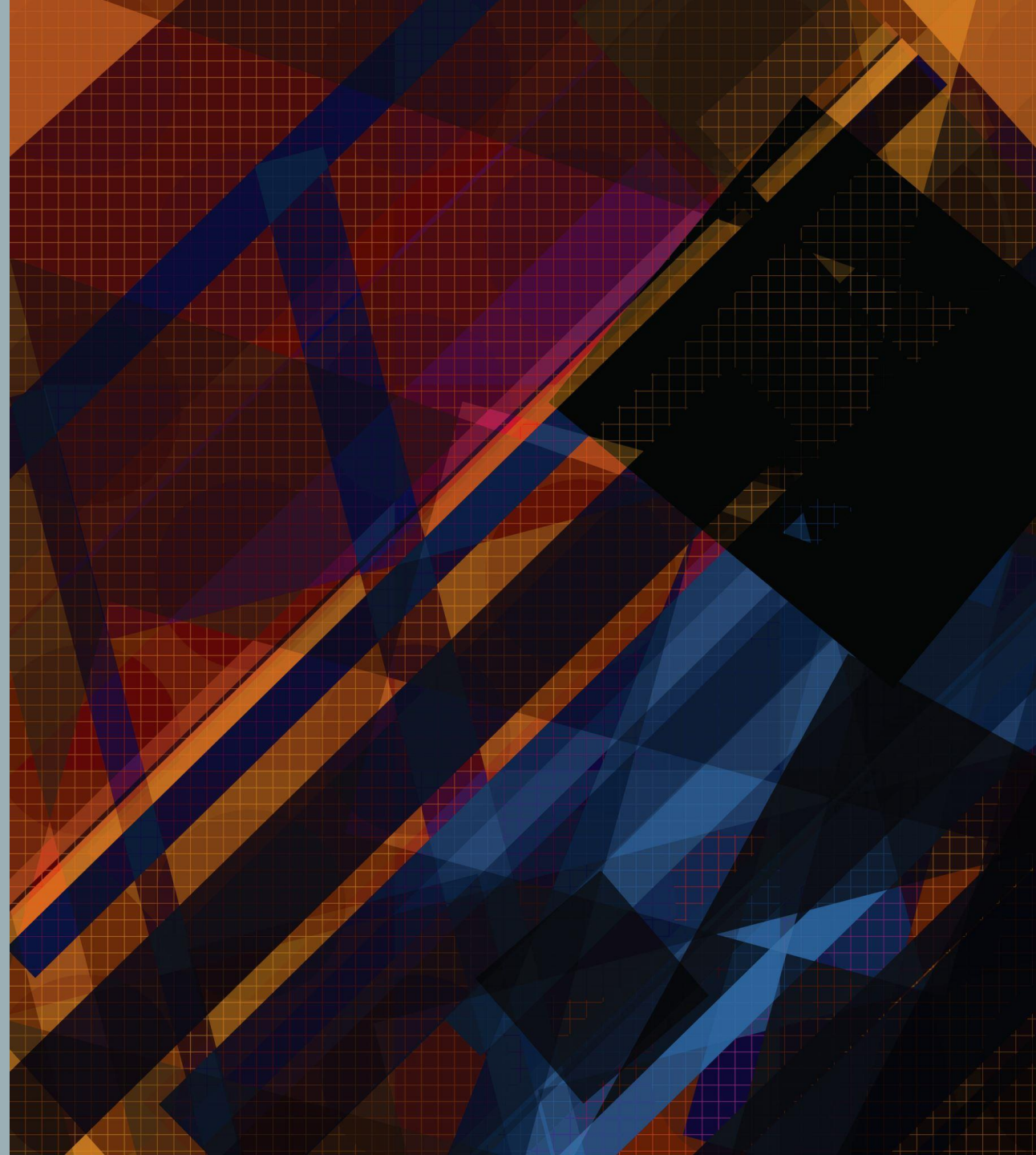

THE TWELVE

12 使徒

- 路加福音 Luke 6:12
One of those days Jesus went out to a mountainside to pray, and spent the night praying to God. 13 When morning came, he called his disciples to him and chose twelve of them, whom he also designated apostles:
- 12 那時，耶穌出去上山禱告，整夜禱告神。 13 到了天亮，叫他的門徒來，就從他們中間挑選十二個人，稱他們為使徒。

MATTHIAS

- 使徒行傳 Acts 1:21-22
“Therefore it is necessary to choose one of the men who have been with us the whole time the Lord Jesus was living among us, 22 beginning from John’s baptism to the time when Jesus was taken up from us. For one of these must become a witness with us of his resurrection.”

- 哥林多前書 1 Cor. 15:6 - 8
After that, he appeared to more than five hundred of the brothers and sisters at the same time, most of whom are still living, though some have fallen asleep. 7 Then he appeared to James, then to all the apostles, 8 and last of all he appeared to me also, as to one abnormally born.

But the Lord said to Ananias, “Go! This man is my chosen instrument to proclaim my name to the Gentiles and their kings and to the people of Israel. 16 I will show him how much he must suffer for my name.”
